| Sanitizing | How to Mix | Solution Strength |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Dishes <br> e.g. cutting boards, <br> knives, cooking utensils | Mix $1 / 2$ teaspoon of <br> household bleach with <br> one litre of water | 100 PPM chlorine solution <br> $\bullet$ immersion |
| Equipment <br> e.g. large equipment, <br> tables, anything that <br> cannot fit into a sink | Mix one teaspoon of <br> household bleach with <br> one litre of water | 200PPM chlorine solution <br> for sanitizing spray <br> • clean-in-place |

## Tips to Remember

- Make a new sanitizing solution daily.
- Do not mix bleach with detergent.
- Using chlorine test strips, check the strength of the solution.
- Discard used sanitizing solution as needed.

The strength of the solution will be weaker after use.
