

How to mix a chlorine solution for sanitizing using bleach



What you will need to start:



1. Ordinary household bleach solution



2. Teaspoon



3. Measuring cup

Sanitizing	How to Mix	Solution Strength
Dishes e.g. cutting boards, knives, cooking utensils	Mix ½ teaspoon of household bleach with one litre of water	100 PPM chlorine solution <ul style="list-style-type: none"> immersion
Equipment e.g. large equipment, tables, anything that cannot fit into a sink	Mix one teaspoon of household bleach with one litre of water	200PPM chlorine solution for sanitizing spray <ul style="list-style-type: none"> clean-in-place

Tips to Remember

- Make a new sanitizing solution daily.
- Do not mix bleach with detergent.
- Using chlorine test strips, check the strength of the solution.
- Discard used sanitizing solution as needed.
The strength of the solution will be weaker after use.
